Weather Observations and Nature Journals

Take your journal outside with you for 10 minutes at the same time each day.

Observe one specific area each day for a week and record what you see, hear, and smell. Make predictions first. For example:

- What color will the sky be when it's sunny out?
- When will I hear the most birds?
- What will it smell like right after it rains?

Each day go outside at the same time to record what's happening. You can draw pictures or just use words. Be sure to write the date on the top of the page each day. Focus on the weather, the colors, the animals, or anything you want. At the end of the week, read your journal and list what has changed or stayed the same.
